



YSU ResNet Network Connection Guide

Cisco Clean Access is a network logon system implemented in 2005 by YSU Network Services. The purpose of Clean Access is to provide a safe and secure experience for you and your Mac while using services on the YSU Network and on the Internet.

To begin using the YSU Network, you must authenticate with the Clean Access System using your YSU Directory Account username and password. Your YSU Directory Account may be referred to as your CUE-Mail or WebCT logon ID.



Step 1: Open your favorite web browser.

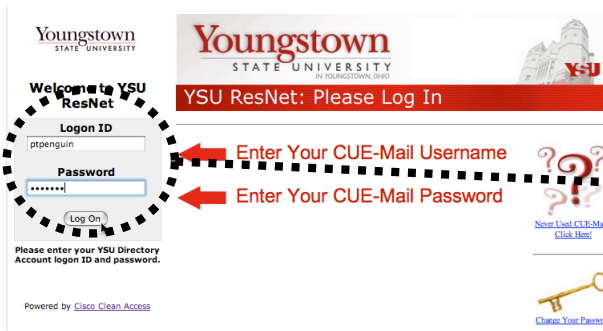

Step 2: Accept the server security certificate for Cisco Clean Access by clicking 'Continue'.
